



City of Girard, Ohio Service Line Inventory Material Notification

As an Ohio Public Water System, the City of Girard is mandated to continually maintain compliance with Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations. The City is requesting your assistance with updating our existing records in an effort to maintain compliance with the Ohio EPA's regulatory requirements. This document outlines the following:

1. A summary of the regulatory requirements published by the U.S. EPA,
2. Directions on how to submit a survey,
3. Website URLs to access service inventory & map, and
4. Website URLs to access to Service Line Inventory Material (SLIM) notifications.

(1) Summary of the Regulatory Requirements: The Lead and Copper Rule Revisions (LCRR) is a federal regulation published by the U.S. EPA. This regulation requires the City of Girard to prepare and maintain an inventory of water service line materials. The City is required to provide notification for customers and all persons served by the water system when their service lines are classified as lead, galvanized requiring replacement (GRR), or lead status unknown. (2) Submitting Survey: The information below outlines four methods for submitting your survey. Please submit your results by **as soon as possible. Customers that have previously submitted a survey are not required to complete a second survey. Please skip to topic (3).**

1. Scan the QR Code to the right with your phone or tablet and fill out survey electronically.
2. Return hardcopy of survey on the back of this document to Girard City Hall when paying your water bill.
3. Email Gaye Martuccio for a copy of the completed survey form.

(3) Service Inventory and Map: Please follow the links below to access the service line inventory and map. Each customer must verify the survey results have been properly recorded. If your service material is not shown properly, please notify the representatives from City of Girard or ms consultants, inc. as presented at the bottom of the page.

(4) SLIM Notifications: Under the authority of the Safe Drinking Water Act, the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) requires the City of Girard to notify water consumers who are served by a lead service lines, galvanized requiring replacement (GRR) service lines, and any service lines where there is no documented evidence supporting the material classification. To help identify the pipe material, please read the descriptions of each pipe below and check the box next to your pipe.



Lead Pipe



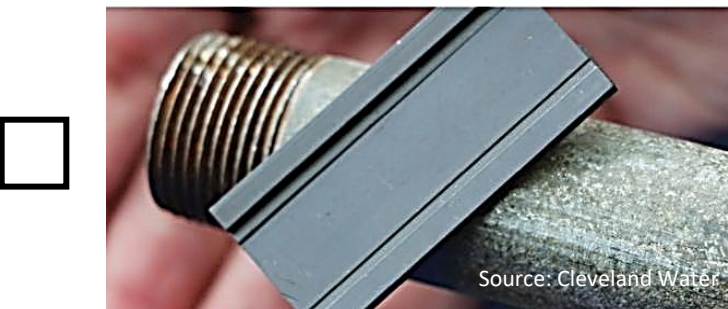
- A magnet will not stick to a lead pipe.
- Scratch the pipe with a coin. If the scraped area is shiny silver and flakes off, the service line is lead.



Copper Pipe



- A magnet will not stick to a copper pipe.
- Scratch the pipe with a penny. If the scraped area is copper in color, like a penny, your service line is copper.



Galvanized Steel Pipe



- If a magnet sticks to the surface, your service line is galvanized steel.
- A scratch test is not needed. If you scratch the pipe, it will remain a dull gray.



PVC Pipes

- Plastic
- A magnet will not stick to them
